Accommodation

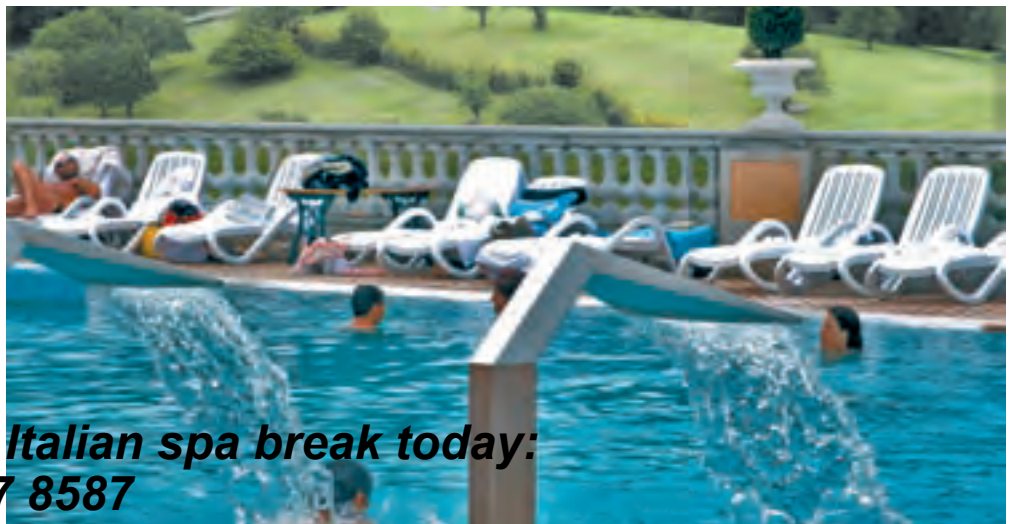
